DAY 1 - ARRIVAL & FIRST PIONEERS (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

Monday, April 13 2026

- Welcome to Israel!!! Land at **Ben Gurion Airport** on Flight # where you will be met by our **VIP service** representative once you exit the plane & escorted through passport control, baggage claim & customs. Please keep your blue slip from Passport Control throughout the trip.
- Meet your guide & driver and start your adventure together!
- Stroll through the immaculately maintained **Rothschild Gardens** a tribute to the man who did so much to promote settlement & agriculture in the area, and have your opening session
- Lunch at Rothschild Gardens (included)
- Visit the Illegal Immigrant Detention camp of Atlit, where Jews attempting to reach the shores of the Land of Israel prior to Independence, were imprisoned by the British. This was also the site of a daring breakout orchestrated by Yitzchak Rabin in 1946.
- Continue towards hotel & check in
- Dinner at hotel (included)
- Participate in a self-organized Yom HaShoah ceremony

DAY 2 - YOM HASHOAH - REBUILDING FROM ASHES (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

Tuesday, April 14 2026

- Full Israeli breakfast at hotel
- Lookout over the world-famous Bahai Gardens in Haifa
- 10:00 am: Commemorate those who were killed in the Holocaust during the two-minute siren that marks Yom Hashoah
- Encounter the heroes who fought against the Nazis during the Holocaust, at the Ghetto Fighters' Museum.
- Meet students and hear the success stories of Yemin Orde a home, school and safe haven to 440 at-risk and immigrant youth from around the world and enjoy lunch with the students
- Meet with Sarit Zehavi founder and president of the Alma Research Education Center for an in-depth analysis of Israel's security & geo-political challenges
- Take a scenic boat ride from Akko to Haifa
- Dinner on own in the Haifa Port
- Return to hotel

DAY 3 - TEL AVIV - START UP NATION (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

- Participate in a **Street Art Graffiti Tour** in downtown Tel Aviv commemorating the heroes of **October 7th** followed by a graffiti workshop where you get to leave your own mark on the urban landscape
- For lunch, enjoy a **cooking workshop** in Tel Aviv
- Behind the scenes tour of the state of the art Marcus National Blood Services Center in Ramle the world's first underground anti-missile blood center
- Continue towards Jerusalem
- Welcome to Jerusalem! Enjoy a spectacular lookout over Jerusalem from the Haas Promenade
- Check in to hotel
- Dinner on own

DAY 4 - JERUSALEM - CITY OF 3 RELIGIONS (GUIDE, TRANSPORTATION)

Thursday, April 16 2026

- Time for reflection at the Western Wall

Exclusive **VIP Tour** in the **City of David** highlighting the newest excavations & areas that are not open to the general public

- Everyone: Explore the Christian Quarter including the Via Dolorosa & Church of the Holy Sepulcher
- Summary of the day at the impressive **Jaffa Gate** and the newly renovated **Tower of David Museum**
- Host IDF soldiers for a BBQ on their base

- Shabbat dinner at the hotel, including hosting a few current IDF Lone Soldiers
- Evening speaker: Aaron Leibovitz educator and started Hashgacha Pratit, a kosher certification independent of the Israeli Chief Rabbinate

Tour of the Jewish Quarter - synagogues, Cardo, broad wall and more

Option 2 (returnees):

Tour of the **neighborhood of Talbiyah**- once a mixed neighborhood and now considered one of the wealthiest in the City. Home to the Prime Minister and President of Israel

- Evening & dinner on own

- Full Israeli breakfast at hotel
- Early departure: Don't forget towels, bathing suit, water, hats and sun screen
- Everyone: Visit with the Ma'ale Adumim Foundation
- Lunch on own en route
- Option 1 (first timers):

Experience the sensation of **floating in the Dead Sea** – the lowest place on Earth - at **Kalya Beach** AND

Ascend the formidable desert fortress of Masada where the Zealots contested the might of the Roman Empire

• Option 2 (returnees):

Discover the fascinating ruins of **Qumeran** where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Understand the life of the Essences

AND

Visit the site of **Qasr Al Yahud**, the place where the Children of Israel and Joshua crossed over the Jordan River into the Promised Land and the Baptismal Site

- Everyone: Transport yourselves to the Days of the Bible as you visit Abraham's Tent in Genesis Land includes
 camel rides, pita-baking, traditional desert hospitality & dinner
- Return to Jerusalem

- Visit the site of the **Nova Festival** & meet with **a survivor** of the attacks
- Stop by a Migunit, the small shelters people hid in during the attacks on October 7th
- Return to hotel
- Enjoy an evening at Gvar'am celebrarting Yom Ha'atzmaut (includes dinner)
- Return to hotel
